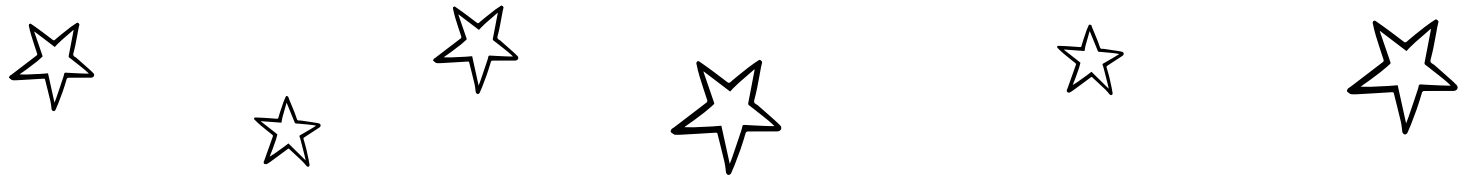

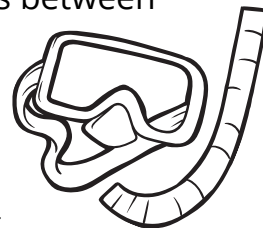

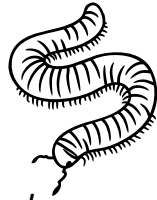
## Self Guided Scavenger Hunt
